The North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District (NLTPFD) is currently recruiting motivated individuals with exceptional customer service skills who are interested in serving the residents of Incline Village and Crystal Bay, Nevada as a Seasonal Firefighter. NLTPFD is nestled in the northeastern portion of the Lake Tahoe Basin, on the Nevada side of the Lake.

This crew conducts all aspects of fuels management activities in the Incline Village and Crystal Bay areas that would reduce the risks from wildfire, especially near the homes in the area. It also functions as an initial and extended-attack fire suppression crew. The crews respond to wildfires across the Sierra Front and the western states to aid in fire suppression. They play a key role in our preparedness to suppress a wildfire here in Incline/Crystal Bay and have responded to assist in flooding, rescues, and any time strong hands are needed to serve our community's public safety needs.

This unique program has been considered a leader in today's fire service. We believe it is far better to remove hazardous fuels before the fire starts. We are concerned about the environment and the future of our community, and we do our best to balance the needs of both.

### DUTIES ARE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- Responds to All Risk and Wildland Fire emergencies as part of a team and performs fire suppression, control and containment of hazardous situations, and fire prevention activities under a variety of conditions and environments.
- Evaluated fire and hazardous situations and determines appropriate equipment and techniques to combat and control the situation(s). Participates in EMS rescues, and extrication activities. And under direction, may participate in fire prevention activities, public education activities, or other programs
- Implements fuels management projects, including fuels management techniques, and forest health
