General summary of the role

Under the direction of the Fire Captain, Firefighter/Paramedic responds to emergency and routine alarms as part of a firefighting/emergency services team; provides on-scene direction to team members while delivering paramedic-level patient care as guided by district protocols; provides public education and performs other related duties.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Be a full-time career Firefighter/Paramedic or in lay off status.
- Has successfully completed a Firefighter Academy
- Minimum of 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or equivalent education.
- Associate or bachelor's degree.
- Two (2) years or more experience as an Advanced Life Support patient care provider in Washoe County.
- Nevada EMS Instructor endorsement.
- Nevada Critical Care Paramedic Endorsement, Certified Critical Care Paramedic (CCP-C), Certified Community Paramedic (CP-C), Certified Flight Paramedic (FP-C), Critical Care Emergency Medical Transport Program (CCEMTTP), Certified Tactical Paramedic (TP-C).
