One of the oldest local government programs in the country, starting in the mid-1990's the NLTFPD's Fuels Management Division has been implementing fuels reduction projects not only within the communities it serves, but also in other jurisdictions within the Tahoe Basin and throughout the state of Nevada. NLTFPD utilizes numerous different strategies and treatments to meet goals and objectives for effective Hazardous Fuels Reduction, while promoting forest health. In addition to these efforts, the NLTFPD utilizes and supports its resources to assist with fire suppression emergencies throughout the United States, providing highly experienced and qualified resources from crews/engines to Incident Management Team members.

DUTIES ARE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

The Crew Fire Captain manages and performs professional level wildland fuels management projects for wildland safety and forest health, along with responding as a supervisor/manager to wildland and other All Risk emergencies when requested. Supervise 6-10 seasonal employees during emergency and daily operations.

Required Qualifications

- Qualified as a Single Resource Boss (CRWB or ENGB) at time of appointment,
- Ability to obtain Single Resource Boss (FIRB) within 18 months of appointment,
- Ability to obtain Prescribed Fire Burn Boss (RXB3) within 24 months of appointment,
- Ability to obtain Strike Team Leader (STCR/STEN) or Task Force Leader (TFLD) within three years per the National Wildfire Coordinating Group Standards (PMS 310-1),
- Must have a valid Nevada or California Class C driver's license to be considered,
- Graduation from high school or equivalent.

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
